

## STUDENT TRANSPORTATION SERVICES

NEPN/NSBA Code: EEA

The law does not relieve parents of students from the responsibility of supervision before the student boards the bus in the morning and after the student leaves the bus at the end of the school day.

The school board will provide transportation for all K-5 students attending Fayette Central School and all those in grades 6-12 attending the contracted tuition schools, to and from school, as approved at Town Meeting. Buses will transport only on town maintained roads and from approved bus stops.

Approved bus stops will be located on town maintained roads so as to load and unload students with the most safety allowed by road conditions. The distance between stops may vary according to safety factors. If possible, students will be loaded and unloaded so that it is not necessary for them to cross a main highway to reach their homes.

Bus turnarounds will be determined each year in a cooperative effort with the Fayette Town Manager.

Middle and high school students will not be allowed to get off the bus at Fayette Country Store, then walk to Fayette Central School, get back on the bus and ride to their designated stop.

Requests for bus stops, inconsistent with this regulation must be made in writing and submitted to the superintendent for consideration. The decision of the superintendent may be appealed to the School Committee.
