DISTRIBUTION OF MATERIALS BY STUDENTS:

Printed materials may be distributed to parents by students as an inexpensive means of communications at Fayette Central School providing:

1. The materials relate to the school, community, local recreational or civic activities.
2. The materials do not promote any political party or candidate.

Requests from Fayette School & Home Association, Underwood Memorial Library group, any other ad-hoc school-town community committees, are examples of the School Committee's intent for possible student distribution.

DISTRIBUTION OF MATERIALS BY THE PUBLIC:

Printed materials may not be distributed to the mailboxes of the staff and School Committee members by the public without prior approval of Administrator and/or designee.

POSTING OF NON-PROFIT/COMMUNITY MATERIALS

Community activities or events that may be of interest to students and/or parents may be posted on the outside sign board and designated bulletin board in the hallway. Any local group may submit such materials. All materials must include a statement that the activity or program is not affiliated with or endorsed by the Fayette School Department. In order to make sufficient space available, priority of events is referenced in KF Community Use of Building-Section 1A (approved uses listed in order of priority use). Printed materials may not be posted without prior approval of Administrator and/or designee.
