PRIVILEGE CONTRACT 2017-2018

Conditions:

1. I must sign out with the Study Hall supervisor and Front Office before leaving the building for any periods that I will be gone. I must sign out in the notebook in the front office indicating where I am going, the people with whom I am traveling, the time I left, and sign back in and initial the time when I return.
2. I must return in time for my next class period.
3. I must act in a responsible manner while off school grounds.
4. I must be in school, on time, and in compliance with the **Attendance Procedure**, to obtain my privileges for that day.
5. I must have written permission from a parent or guardian in order to transport or ride with other juniors/seniors. Details are listed below.
6. I may only transport as many juniors/seniors as my vehicle has **working** seat belts.
7. I understand that if the road conditions are questionable, my privileges may be canceled for a period of time, until the Administrative Staff determines that the roads are safe.
8. I will not transport students of other grade levels or juniors/seniors without privileges during school hours unless given permission by the front office.
9. My privileges may be revoked, assuming due process, at the discretion of the Administrative Staff.
10. I must have my emergency card on file in the Health Center, show proof of insurance, and have no outstanding school bills. I must also sign the school handbook form and this contract before privileges will be granted.
11. I must be academically responsible. I must not be in silent study. I must have at least a 2.7 GPA with no grades below a C and no incompletes. In addition, after the first 6 weeks of the semester, I must also have a HOW average of at least a 2.25 in all my classes, with no individual scores of lower than a 2, to be eligible for privileges. This will be checked every 6 weeks. If I am missing grades due to an excused absence, I have one week to make them up to become eligible. Privileges will initially be determined by the 2nd semester grades from the previous year if the 6 week mark of the first semester has not been reached.
12. I understand that if I decide to drop a class **without** the permission of the instructor **and** the guidance office, **I am no longer eligible for Off-Campus Privileges.**
13. Violation of the school's driving or parking regulations will result in the loss of privilege for a time that will be determined by an administrator.

Conditions for Balcony and Beach (These are for seniors only):

1. I understand I must respect all current Media Center Expectations for the Balcony.
2. Be responsible for yourself and others.
3. Respect the Balcony space.
4. Limit is 8 students on the balcony at one time.
5. I understand that I must keep the beach clean and respect all school rules and property. I must also respect the surrounding classrooms and keep the noise level down. Objects such as balls etc., may not be thrown due to safety reasons.
6. School staff may remove any students from the Beach who do not follow the guidelines.
7. The Media Center staff have the discretion to remove students from the Balcony who violate the guidelines.
8. Students who are removed from the Beach, Balcony, or the Media Center will be subject to the disciplinary process.

Sign out privileges guidelines:

1. This is a privilege, not a right! You must abide by all the rules if you want to keep yourself in good standing. This includes driving and parking rules. No reckless or dangerous driving.
2. You must sign out in the notebook that is provided in the front office.
3. You can only sign yourself out, and you must write legibly.
4. When you sign back in, put the time you returned and *initial* the time.
5. If you are late (unexcused) to homeroom, or are late signing in, and/or show up late to class, you will lose your privileges. (2 days on the first offense, 2 weeks on the second offense, and for 8 weeks or the Semester whichever is longer on the third offense). (**Allow yourself time to sign in and get to your locker and to class on time!**)
6. A violation of the transportation rule (riding with, or transporting underclassmen or juniors/seniors without privileges) is automatic loss for the Semester.
7. You must sign out with your Study Hall Supervisor **BEFORE** signing out in the front office. If you have lunch...tell them before you leave, so they know that you will not be back to Study Hall! **You may not sign out just for lunch.** If you have two Study Halls in a row, you may leave for both of them, but must sign out with the both study hall supervisors and the front office before doing so.
8. You must be on the privilege list in order to be able to use them. The list is in the front office posted nearby the sign out location. If you are not on this list...you are missing one or more pieces of information and **YOU DO NOT HAVE PRIVILEGES.**
9. Further rules governing Off-Campus Privileges may be added as needed.
