At the end of the day, another batch of students carried all of the clothing from the library (the “collection site” – thanks!) to the health center, and Anya & Tabbitha delivered all of the supplies we assembled, to Mt. Vernon. Meanwhile, others have started a GoFundMe for the family. It was heartening to see so many people scampering around the school, working together to help in some way. That’s one of the many positive aspects of our public school community!
